What is Children's Chapel and it's purpose?

The purpose of Children's Chapel is NOT to provide babysitting or entertainment.

Children's Chapel is a liturgical experience where children enter into a prepared mini church, read the gospel story, reflect on the gospel, pray for the church and persona intentions, then rejoin the congregation for the liturgy of the Eucharist.

What is the purpose of dismissing children?

The children are dismissed to provide them with a focused environment where they receive age appropriate liturgy and have the opporutity to respond to God's Word.
